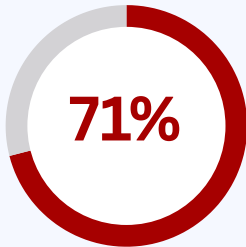




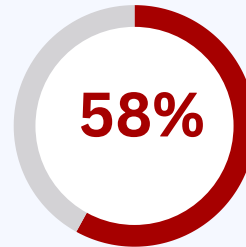
New Poll Finds That Nearly Three-Fourths Of American Voters Want More Renewable Energy

KEY FINDINGS FROM SEPTEMBER 2026 POLL SHOW:

- ✓ 79% favor solar energy
- ✓ 74% favor wind energy
- ✓ 70% say energy bills have gone up in the past year
- ✓ 60% oppose data center construction in local area
- ✓ 62% want local residents to decide data center placement
